



## Little Pig

**Yarn:** [La Mia Cottony](#) from Hobium Yarns in grey and pink.

**Hook size:** 3 mm

**Size:** appr 10 cm

### Good to know

- Crochet in a spiral, without ending each round, if nothing else is told.
- Use a piece of scrap yarn or a marker to keep track of the beginning/end of the rows.
- Total number of stitches at the end of the round between ().
- Instructions between \*-\* is repeated around or the number of times specified.
- Instructions between (-) is made in the same stitch/chainspace.
- Arms and legs are crocheted together with the body, if you prefer you can finish the body without attaching the arms and legs and attach them later.



### Abbreviations US

mc – magic circle

ch – chain

st – stitch

slst – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

rnd – round

sk – skip

prev – previous

sc2tog – single crochet next 2 stitches together as one (decrease)

2in1 – 2 sc in next st (increase)

BLO – back loops only



## **Pattern**

### **Head (pink)**

1. 6 sc in a mc. (6)
2. \*2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)
3. \*1 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (18)
4. \*2 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (24)
5. \*3 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (30)
6. \*4 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (36)
- 7-10. 1 sc in each st. (36)
11. \*4 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (30)
12. 1 sc in each st. (30)
13. \*3 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (24)
14. 1 sc in each st. (24)
15. \*2 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (18)

*Begin filling the head and continue to do so the last rounds.*

16. \*1 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)
17. \*sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (6)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end to close the opening.

### **Leg (grey and pink, make 2)**

*Begin with grey.*

1. 6 sc in a mc. (6)
2. \*2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)
3. \*1 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (18)
4. In BLO. 1 sc in each st. (18)

*Change to pink.*

- 5-7. 1 sc in each st. (18)
8. \*1 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)

*Stuff lightly.*

- 9-11. 1 sc in each st. (12)

Flatten the leg and crochet 6 sc across to close.

### **Arm (grey and pink, make 2)**

*Begin with grey.*

1. 6 sc in a mc. (6)
2. \*2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)
3. In BLO. 1 sc in each st. (12)

*Change to pink.*

- 4-6. 1 sc in each st. (12)

*Stuff lightly.*

7. \*sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (6)

Flatten the arm and crochet 3 sc across to close.



**Body (pink)**

1. 6 sc in a mc. (6)
2. \*2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (12)
3. \*1 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (18)
4. \*2 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (24)

*Now it's time to crochet the legs together with the body. Place the hook through the stitch on the leg and through the next stitch on the body, finish like a regular sc.*

5. 3 sc on the body, 6 sc through first leg and body, 6 sc on the body, 6 sc through second leg and body, 3 sc on the body. (24)
6. \*3 sc, 2in1\*, rep \*-\* around. (30)
- 7-10. 1 sc in each st. (30)
11. \*3 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (24)
- 12-13. 1 sc in each st. (24)
14. \*2 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. (18)

*Begin filling the body and continue during the final rounds.*

*Time to crochet the arms and body together. Do it the same way as you did with the legs and body.*

15. 6 sc on the body, 3 sc through first arm and body, 6 sc on the body, 3 sc through second arm and body. (18)
16. 1 sc in each st. (18)
17. \*1 sc, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* around. End with a slst in next st. (12)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end to attach the head to the body.

**Ear (pink, make 2)**

Ch 5.

1. Begin in second ch from hook, 4 sc. Turn.
2. Ch 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn.
3. Ch 1, sk first st, 3 sc. Turn.
4. Ch 1, sk first st, 2 sc. Turn.
5. Ch 1, sk first st, 1 sc.

Cut the yarn. Leave an end long enough to attach the ear to the head.

**Nose (pink)**

In a mc crochet;

3 sc, 3 hdc, 3 sc, 3 hdc. End with a slst to first st.

Cut the yarn. Leave an end long enough to attach the nose to the head.

## **Assembly**

- Center the body under the head and attach it.
- Attach the ears to the sides of the head, between row 4 and row 8.
- Attach the nose between row 8 and row 12, in the center of the head. Embroider nostrils with black.
- Embroider eyes on the head, just above the nose, with black.
- To make the tail I took 3 strands of pink yarn and twisted them together. Then I attached them to the back of the pig.



And now your little pig is ready for adventure!
