# PATTERN SUMMER BELT BAG



## MATERIALS

- 1 Kartopu Macrame 100 gr. You can buy here: https://www.hobiumyarns.com/urun/detay/kartopu-macrame-macrame-cord-cream-k025
- Crochet hook 5 mm.
- Zipper 30 cm
- Others: patches or anything that you prefer, needle, pins and scissor.



## STITCHES

- Magic ring
- Single crochet (SC)
- Slip stitch
- Increase of single crochet

## PATTERN

#### **Circles**

Crocheting summer belt bag you have to crochet 2 equal circles.

Begin with a magic ring.

Row 1: Into the magic ring crochet 6 SC. Mark last stitch.

Row 2: Crochet an increase single crochet in each stitch of row 1. In total 12 SC. Crochet in spiral so you have to crochet the first increase on the last stitch the previous row, the one you marked.

If you need it, place a marker on the last stitch of each row to remember that it stitch will be the first one that you crochet in the next row.

Row 3: Crochet a squence of 1 SC, 1 increase (2 SC on the same stitch), 1 SC, 1 increase, ... Until completing the row with a total 18 SC.

Row 4: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 2 SC until completing the row with a total 24 SC.

Row 5: Crochet a squence of 3 SC followed by 1 increase until completing the row with a total 30 SC.

Row 6: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 4 SC until completing the row with a total 36 SC.

Row 7: Crochet a squence of 5 SC followed by 1 increase until completing the row with a total 42 SC.

Row 8: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 6 SC until completing the row with a total 48 SC.

Row 9: Crochet 3 SC and after a sequence of 1 increase followed by 7 SC until completing the row with a total 54 SC.

Row 10: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 8 SC until completing the row with a total 60 SC.

Row 11: Crochet a squence of 9 SC followed by 1 increase until completing the row with a total 66 SC.

Row 12: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 10 SC until completing the row with a total 72 SC.

Row 13: Crochet 6 SC and after a sequence of 1 increase followed by 11 PB until completing the row with a total 78 SC.

Row 14: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 12 SC until completing the row with a total 84 SC.

Row 15: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 13 SC until completing the row with a total 90 SC.

Row 16: Teje 7 SC and after a sequence of 1 increase followed by 14 SC until completing the row with a total 96 SC.

Row 17: Crochet a squence of 1 increase followed by 15 SC until completing the row with a total 102 SC.

When you finish the last row, crochet a slip stitch and curt de yarn. Now you have crochet other equal circle.

Size circle 18,5 cm.

### Loop

Crochet a rectangle with single crochet.

Size of my loop 14 cm x 4,5 cm.

#### **Assemble belt bag**

Now that you have the two circles and the loop for the belt you just have to assemble.

First, sew to one of the circles the patches or the decoration that you have chosen and the loop to the other circle. Important! Make sure that in both cases you are sewing them on the right side.

Now, place the two circles backside together and crochet 54 slip stitchs joining the two circles and leaving only an open space for the zipper.

Once you have crocheted 54 SC, it ends with a slip stitch and cut yarn.

In the open space, sew the zipper. I suggest to use pins to hold the zipper in place, it will be easier to sew it.

Now you only have to enjoy your summer belt bag!;)
