

The Triple Cable Cowl

Designed by Zach Stout

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Materials/Gauge

Hook: I - 5.5 mm

Yarn: 4 weight/worsted; I used La Mia Diamond in color L 167 by Hobium Yarns

Yardage: 420m/460yd

My cowl measured 32 in/81 cm prior to being seamed.

Stitches used in this project

ch- chain

hdc- half double crochet

dc- double crochet

bpdc- back post double crochet

fpdc- front post double crochet

fptc- front post treble crochet

Notes

Ch 3 at beginning of Rows 1/3 count as dc

Ch 2 at beginning of Rows 2/4 count as hdc

Pattern Instructions

Ch 41

Dc in 4th chain from the hook and dc all the way down (39 dc)

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in the next 2 dc, *skip 3 dc, fptc in next 3 dc, return to first skipped dc, fptc in first skipped dc and following 2 dc, fpdc in next 3 dc, dc in next 3 dc* Repeat from * to * 2 more times, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in the next 2 dc, *bpdc in next 9 st (fpdc stitches), hdc in next 3 dc* Repeat from * to * 2 more times, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in the next 2 hdc, *fpdc in the next 3 st, skip 3 st, fptc in the next 3 st, return to first skipped st, fptc in first skipped st and following 2 st, dc in the next 3 hdc* Repeat from * to * 2 more times, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in the next 2 dc, *bpdc in next 9 st (fpdc stitches), hdc in next 3 dc* Repeat from * to * 2 more times, turn.

Repeat rows 1-4 until desired length, ending on row 2.

Once complete, use slip stitch seam to join ends ensuring cables and dc columns align.
