

LINKED KNITTED PILLOW

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Materials:

- US 13 or 9.0mm Knitted Needles or Circular Needles with 16-inch cord.
- Super Bulky weight #6
- ♦ 14 x 14 Pillow
- Large Tapestry Needle

<u>Yards/Ounces:</u> Kartopu Home Décor, 14.5 ounces, 400 grams or 262 yards.

Skill Level: Beginner

Size: 14 x 14 pillow

Gauge: 4 x 4 inches = 12 stitches x 12 rows of

stockinette.

Dimensions: 14 x 15 square

Abbreviations:

k1 = knit 1 stich

p1 = purl 1 stitch

sl1k = slip 1 knit wise, bring yarn through needles to front, right needle through top stitch as if to knit and slip stitch onto right needle.



Work up two squares following this pattern for one pillow.

PATTERN:

With Needles Cast on 41 stitches.

Row 1: P2, k1, p2. Repeat * k1, p2* to the end of the row. (41 stitches)

Row 2: K2, sl1k, k2. Repeat *sl1k, k2* to the end of the row. (41 stitches)

Row 3 - 54: Repeat alternating row 2 and 3. Cut a tail to sew in. You will use the leftover yarn for sewing pillows together.



ASSEMBLY:

You will have 2 squares. Make sure your stitches are facing up and turn right sides together. If you have a crochet hook of size 8.0 mm, you slip stitch from the left corner to top, across top and down other side. If not, you can use a large tapestry needle and a long piece of yarn and whip stitch 3 sides. Make sure the bottom that is open is the 1st row you started with. Knot your ends on the inside.

Turn the right side out and slip your pillow inside. With an invisible or ladder stitch sew up bottom, weave in your end in and fasten off.

Enjoy your pillow or pillows!!

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
