Corie the Little Chick

Corie the Little Chick Crochet is the first pattern of my crochet farm animal friends. It's made before Easter. Because I wanted to give people an Easter treat, I decided to make a little chicken amigurumi. My daughter also enjoys playing with our chickens at home so it's also a treat for her.

Difficulty Level: Intermediate

Finished size: approximately 6.5 inches if you will use same yarn and hook

Gauge: 1.75mm Hook:1 inch = 11 stitches and 11 rows **2mm Hook:** 1 inch = 10 stitches and 8 rows

Materials Needed

- 1.75mm and 2mm Hook
- Light Fingering Weight Yarn
 (YarnArt Cotton Soft)
 - color: yellow, red, white,
 orange, (pink optional)
 *Yarn can be substituted with
 fine yarns (ex: YarnArt Jeans or
 Catania Originals) but using
 bigger hooks
- Yarn Needle

- Stitch Marker
- 5mm Red Ribbon (if you're using a different yarn, then check the length inside a double crochet)
- Polyester Fiberfill Stuffing
- 8mm Safety Eyes (if you're using a different yarn, then it will depend on the size of your doll)

Pattern Notes

- The pattern is using US terminology.
- Stuff as firmly as you can unless otherwise specified. Stuffing is the key to make or break your doll. If the body is too big for the head, then the head needs more stuffing. If the head is too big, then more stuffing is needed for the body.
- Work in continuous rounds unless otherwise specified.
- Work in both loops unless otherwise specified.
- You can use any yarn as long as you will use the appropriate hook size (smaller size than the recommended one) but the size of your doll will be different.

USE 1.75MM HOOK

HEAD (use yellow)

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: (SC 2, INC) x 6. (24)

R5: (SC 3, INC) x 6. (30)

R6: (SC 4, INC) x 6. (36)

R7: (SC 5, INC) x 6. (42)

R8: (SC 6, INC) x 6. (48)

R9: (SC 7, INC) x 6. (54)

R10: (SC 8, INC) x 6. (60)

R11: (SC 9, INC) x 6. (66)

R12: (SC 10, INC) x 6. (72)

R13-22: SC in each st around. (72)

- Place the safety eyes in between R18

and R19, 10 stitches apart.

R23: (SC 10, DEC) x 6. (66)

R24: (SC 9, DEC) x 6. (60)

R25: (SC 8, DEC) x 6. (54)

R26: (SC 7, DEC) x 6. (48)

R27: (SC 6, DEC) x 6. (42)

R28: (SC 5, DEC) x 6. (36)

R29: (SC 4, DEC) x 6. (30)

R30: (SC 3, DEC) x 6. (24) - Stuff

R31: (SC 2, DEC) x 6. (18)

R32: (SC, DEC) x 6. (12)

R33: DEC x 6. (6)

- FO. Stuff firmly as you can.

*sl st. FO. You can put some blush on the cheeks by embroidering with pink



WINGS (make 2, use yellow)

R1: Ch 4, starting in second ch from the hook, SC 2, 3 SC in last ch, SC and INC in

the other side of the ch. (8)

R2: INC, SC 6, INC. (10)

R3: INC, SC 2, DEC, SC 4, INC. (11)

R4: SC 9 , INC, SC. (12)

R5: INC, SC 2, DEC, SC 5, INC 2. (14)

R6: SC 4, DEC, SC 5, INC, SC 2. (14)

R7: SC 11, INC, SC 2. (15)

R8: SC 3, DEC, SC 5, INC, SC 4. (15)

R9: SC 10, INC, SC 4. (16)

R10: SC in each st around. (16)

R11: SC 3, INC, SC 12. (17)

R12: SC 12, INC, SC 4. (18)

R13: SC 3, INC, SC 14. (19)

R14: SC in each st around. (19)

R15: SC 4, INC, SC 14. (20)

R16: SC 5, INC, SC 8, DEC, SC 4. (20)

R17: SC 6, INC, SC 13. (21)

R18: SC 6, INC, SC 8, DEC, SC 4. (21)

R19: SC in each st around. (21)

R20: SC 16, DEC, SC 3. (20)

R21: SC 5, DEC, SC 9, DEC, SC 2. (18)

R22: SC 5, DEC, SC 7, DEC, SC 2. (16)

R23: DEC, SC 3, DEC, SC, DEC, SC 2, DEC

2. (11)

*sl st. FO. These will be crocheted together in the last 3rd and 2nd round of the body.



BEAK (use orange)

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: (INC, SC 2) x 2. (8)

R3: (SC, INC) x 4. (12)

R4: (SC 2, INC) x 4. (16)

-FO. Leave tail. Sew in between the last round where the eyes were placed. Stuff a little before

closing.





CROWN (use orange)

- Divide the top crown to three parts: A, B, C
- CROWN A

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: (SC, INC) x 3. (9)

R3: (SC 2, INC) x 3. (12)

R4-6: SC in each st around. (12) - FO.

CROWN B

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)


R2: INC 6. (12)


R3: (SC 2, INC) x 4. (16)


R4-8: SC in each st around. (16) - FO.

- CROWN C
- Follow CROWN A for R1-6.
- Continue to crochet to CROWN B R7: SC 8 in CROWN B, SC 12 IN CROWN A, SC 8 in CROWN B, (SC 10, DEC) in CROWN C. (39) R8: SC 7, DEC, SC 4, DEC, SC 4, DEC, SC 6, DEC, SC 4, DEC, SC 4. (34)

FO. Leave tail for sewing. Stuff. Sew on to the middle top of the head. Use ballpoint pins if you have to to secure the placement of the crown.













LEGS (make 2, use yellow)

R1: Start with yellow, MR, ch 1,

SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: (SC 5, INC) x 3. (21)

R5-8: SC in each st around. (21)

R9: INC, SC 20. (22)

R10: SC in each st around. (22)

R11: INC, SC 21. (23)

R12: INC, SC 22. (24)

R13: INC, SC 23. (25)

R14: INC, SC 24. (26)

R15: INC, SC 25. (27)

R16: INC, SC 26. (28)

R17: INC, SC 27. (29)

R18: INC, SC 28. (30)

*stuff firmly. FO on the LEG 1 only. LEG 2 will continue on

with the body.

To connect the legs (BODY R19):

 Attach the yarn from where 2. SC in LEG 1 you left off of LEG 1.





3.SC 3 in one side of the ch

4. R19 of BODY is complete





BODY (use orange and red)

R19: Continue from the LEG 2 using yellow, ch 3, SC in the next st where you left off of LEG 1, SC 29 (LEG 1), SC 3 in one side of the ch, SC 30 (LEG 2), SC 3 in the other side of the ch. (66)

R20: SC 29, INC, SC, INC, SC, INC, SC 27, DEC, SC 3. (68)

R21: DEC, SC 66. (67)

R22: SC in each st around. (67)

R23: SC 18, INC, SC 8, INC, SC 8, INC, SC 8, INC, SC

21. (71)

R24-25: SC in each st around. (71)

R26: SC 18, DEC, SC 8, DEC, SC 8, DEC, SC 8, DEC,

SC 21. (67)

R27: SC 17, DEC, SC 7, DEC, SC 8, DEC, SC 7, DEC,

SC 20. (63)

R28: SC 22, DEC, SC 5, DEC, SC 5, DEC, SC 25. (60)

R29: (DEC, SC 8) x 6. (54)

R30: SC in each st around. (54)

R31: Change to Red, (SC 7, DEC) x 6. (48)

R32-33: SC in each st around. (48)

R34: BLO, (DEC, SC 6) x 6. (42)

Work in Back Loops Only for R34.



Crochet the wings together with the body.



R35-36: SC in each st around. (42)

R37: (DEC, SC 5) x 6. (36)

R38: SC in each st around. (36)

R39: (DEC, SC 4) x 6. (30) - Stuff

*Below, I put an N as the number of st moved in case the wings are not in the sides, which means your starting st has moved. Following the instructions below, subtract N to get the number of SCs you need to make before crocheting the wings. Note: You don't need to subtract anything if you're starting st is only slightly to the left like in the photo. I marked a line so you can see where my starting sts are.



R40: (SC 18 - N), (together with wing, SC 5),

(SC 7 - N). (30)

R41: (SC 2 - N), (together with wing, SC 5), (SC 17 - N). (30)

R42: (DEC, SC 3) x 6. (24)

R43: (SC 2, DEC) x 6. (18)

– Stuff. FO. Leave tail to sew to the head (between the last 4th and 3rd Round).

USE 2MM HOOK

BALLOON SHORTS (use white)

-is worked by joining each rounds with a sl st. Make the shorts starting from top to bottom. Attach a white yarn at the front loop, last stitch of R33 of the body.

R1: Ch 1, SC 48, sl st. (48)

R2: Ch 2, DC 48, sl st. (48)

R3: Ch 1, (SC 7, INC) x 6, sl st. (54)

R4: Ch 1, (SC 8, INC) x 6, sl st. (60)

R5: Ch 1, (SC 9, INC) x 6, sl st. (66)

R6: Ch 2, (HDC 5, INC) x 11, sl st. (77)

R7: Ch 2, HDC in each st around, sl st. (77)

- Continue making right side of the shorts only.

R8: Ch 7, skip 38 st, sl st to 39th st, ch 2

(HDC, DEC) x 15, HDC, sl st. (31)

R9: Ch 2, (HDC, DEC) x 10, HDC. (21) - FO

Attach a white yarn at the front loop, last st of R33 of the BODY.



Finishing R1 of SHORTS with a sl st.



- Now to make the left side of the shorts.

R1: Facing the back of the doll, attach a white yarn in the last st of R7.

- Ch 2 in the last st of R7, (HDC, DEC) x 15, HDC, sl st. (31)

R2: Ch 2, (HDC, DEC) x 10, HDC. (21) - FO

Crocheting the legs of the SHORTS

1. For left side of the shorts, ch 7.



3. Ch 2, HDC in the same st.



2. Connect to the opposite side with a sl st.



4. To crochet the right side of the SHORTS, ch 2 in the last st of R7.



- Using a yarn needle, insert a red ribbon through R2 of the SHORTS. Tie a ribbon in the middle front.
- To prevent the ends from fraying, you can apply nail polish or apply heat (use a lighter) to melt the fibers together.
- To keep the ribbon in place, sew the back on to the SHORTS.
