# PRASA THE PIGLET AMIGURUMI

# **Prasa the Piglet Amigurumi**

Prasa the piglet is the second amigurumi pattern of my crochet farm animal series. I decided to make a piggy because I wanted to do something with my pink yarn. I like the color pink and if I can use it to make a stuffed animal, much better. I also like watching cartoons before where piggies were wearing sailor uniforms. They all look so cute in it so I made my own version of a wanna-be-sailor piglet amigurumi.

**Difficulty Level:** Advanced Beginner

Finished size: approximately 6 inches if you will use same yarn and hook

**Gauge:** 1 inch = 10 stitches and 11 rows

#### Materials Needed

- 1.75mm Hook
- Light Fingering Weight Yarn (YarnArt Cotton Soft)
  - color: pink, blue, white
  - \*Yarn can be substituted wtih fine weight yarns (YarnArt Jeans or Catonia Originals) but use a 2mm Hook. Of course, you can also use bigger weight yarns like YarnArt Jeans Plus to make it fluffier
- Yarn Needle
- Stitch Marker (advisable)
- Polyester Fiberfill Stuffing
- 8mm Safety Eyes (if you're using a different yarn, then it will depend on the size of your doll)

#### **Pattern Notes**

- The pattern is using US terminology.
- Stuff as firmly as you can unless otherwise specified. Stuffing is the key to make or break your doll. If the body is too big for the head, then the head needs more stuffing. If the head is too big, then more stuffing is needed for the body.
- Work in continuous rounds unless otherwise specified.
- Work in both loops unless otherwise specified.
- You can use any yarn as long as you will use the appropriate hook size (smaller size than the recommended one) but the size of your doll will be different.

#### **HEAD** (use pink)

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: (SC 2, INC) x 6. (24)

R5: (SC 3, INC) x 6. (30)

R6: (SC 4, INC) x 6. (36)

R7: (SC 5, INC) x 6. (42)

R8: (SC 6, INC) x 6. (48)

R9: (SC 7, INC) x 6. (54)

R10: (SC 8, INC) x 6. (60)

R11: (SC 9, INC) x 6. (66)

R12: (SC 10, INC) x 6. (72)

R13-22: SC in each st around. (72)

- Place the safety eyes in between R18

and R19, 10 stitches apart.

R23: (SC 10, DEC) x 6. (66)

R24: (SC 9, DEC) x 6. (60)

R25: (SC 8, DEC) x 6. (54)

R26: (SC 7, DEC) x 6. (48)

R27: (SC 6, DEC) x 6. (42)

R28: (SC 5, DEC) x 6. (36)

R29: (SC 4, DEC) x 6. (30)

R30: (SC 3, DEC) x 6. (24) - Stuff

R31: (SC 2, DEC) x 6. (18)

R32: (SC, DEC) x 6. (12)

R33: DEC x 6. (6)

- FO. Stuff firmly as you can.

\*sl st. FO. You can put some blush on the cheeks or embroider it with pink yarn if you want to.



#### EARS (make 2, use pink)

-always start your SC in the same st where you do your ch.

R1: Ch 3, SC, INC, ch 1. (3)

R2: Turn, SC 2, INC, ch 1. (4)

R3: Turn, SC 3, INC, ch 1. (5)

R4: Turn, SC 4, INC, ch 1. (6)


R5: Turn, SC 5, INC, ch 1. (7)

R6: Turn, SC 6, INC, ch 1. (8)

R7: Turn, SC 8, c. (8)

R8: Turn, SC 8. (8)

- FO. Leave long tail to sew on to the top side of the head between rounds 7-14.



### NOSE (use pink)

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)


R4: SI st in each st around. (18)

R5: Work in the back of R4, which is R3, SC in each st around. (18)

- No need to sl st to finish the round.

R6: SC in each st around. (18)

– FO. Leave long tail to sew in between the last round where the eyes were placed. Stuff lightly before closing.



#### LEGS (make 2, use pink)

R1: Start with pink, MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: (SC 5, INC) x 3. (21)

R5-8: SC in each st around. (21)

R9: INC, SC 20. (22)

R10: SC in each st around. (22)

R11: SC 10, INC, SC 11. (23)

R12: SC 11, INC, SC 11. (24)

R13: SC 12, INC, SC 11. (25)

R14: SC 12, INC, SC 12. (26)

R15: SC 13, INC, SC 12. (27)

R16: SC 13, INC, SC 13. (28)

R17: SC 14, INC, SC 13. (29)

R18: SC 14, INC, SC 14. (30)

\*stuff firmly. FO on LEG 1 only. LEG 2

will continue on with the body.

#### BODY (use pink and blue)

R19: Continue from the LEG 2 using pink, ch 3, SC in the next st where you left off of LEG 1, SC 29 (LEG 1), SC 3 in one side of the ch, SC 30 (LEG 2),

SC 3 in the other side of the ch. (66)

R20: SC 29, INC, SC, INC, SC, INC, SC 27, DEC, SC 3. (68)

R21: DEC, SC 66. (67)

R22: SC in each st around. (67)

R23: SC 18, INC, SC 8, INC, SC 8, INC, SC 8, INC, SC

21. (71)

R24-25: SC in each st around. (71)

R26: SC 20, DEC, SC 6, DEC, SC 8, DEC, SC 6, DEC,

SC 23. (67)

R27: SC 18, DEC, SC 5, DEC, SC 8, DEC, SC 5, DEC,

SC 23. (63)

R28: SC 22, DEC, SC 5, DEC, SC 5, DEC, SC 25.(60)

R29: (DEC, SC 8) x 6. (54)

R30: SC in each st around. (54)

R31: (SC 7, DEC) x 6. (48)

R32-33: SC in each st around. (48)

R34: (DEC, SC 6) x 6. (42)

#### To connect the legs (BODY R19):

1. Ch 3 in LEG 2.



2. SC in LEG 1.



3. R19 of BODY is complete.



#### Do not distribute, sell or share this pattern

R35: SC in each st around. (42)

R36: SC 18, change to blue, SC 24. (42)

R37: (DEC, SC 5) x 2, DEC, SC 2, Work in

BLO, SC 3, (DEC, SC 5) x 3. (36)

R38: Cont to work in BLO, SC 18, work in

both loops, SC 18. (36)

R39: (DEC, SC 4) x 5, DEC, SC 3, change to

pink, SC. (30)

R40: Change to blue, SC 28, change to

pink, SC 2. (30)

R41: SC, change to blue, SC 2, DEC, (SC 3,

DEC) x 4, SC 2, change to pink, SC, DEC.

(24)

R42: SC 2, change to blue, SC 19, change

to pink, SC 3. (24)

R43: SC 2, DEC, change to blue, (SC 2, DEC)

x 4, SC, change to pink, SC, DEC. (18)

- FO. Stuff. Leave long tail to sew to the head (between the last 4th and 3rd

Round).



#### SKIRT (use blue, white)

- Make the skirt starting from top to bottom. Attach a blue yarn at the front loop of R38 of the body.

R1: Ch 1, SC in the same st, SC 11, INC, SC 12, INC, SC 12, INC. (42) – no need to sl st.

R2: (SC 6, INC) x 6. (48)

R3: SC in each st around. (48)

R4: (SC 7, INC) x 6. (54)

R5: SC in each st around. (54)

R6: (SC 8, INC) x 6. (60)

R7: (SC 9, INC) x 6. (66)

R8: (SC 10, INC) x 6. (72)

R9: (SC 11, INC) x 6. (78)

R10: (SC 12, INC) x 6. (84)

R11: (SC 13, INC) x 6. (90)

R12: (SC 14, INC) x 6. (96)

R13: SC in each st around. (96)

R14: (SC 15, INC) x 6. (102)

R15-17: SC in each st around. (102)

R18: Change to white, SC in each st around.

(102)

R19: SC in each st around. (102)

- FO

Attach a blue yarn at the front loop of R38 of the BODY.



#### ARMS (make 2, use pink, blue, white)

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: SC in each st around. (18)

R5: (SC 5, INC) x 3. (21)

R6: (SC 6, INC) x 3. (24)

R7-11: SC in each st around. (24)

R12: (SC 6, DEC) x 3. (21)

R13-16: SC in each st around. (21)

R17: (SC 5, DEC) x 3. (18)

R18-19: SC in each st around. (18)

R20: Change to blue, SC in each st around. (18)

R21: Change to white, SC in each st around. (18)

R22: Change to blue, (SC 4, DEC) x 3. (15)

R23-24: SC in each st around. (15)

\*sl st. FO. Leave long tail for sewing. Stuff lightly so that you can flatten the opening and sew them on the sides of the body. Sew it in between R41 and R42 of the body.





#### HAT (use blue, white)

-always start your SC in the same st where you do your ch.

R1: MR, ch 1, SC 6. (6)

R2: INC 6. (12)

R3: (SC, INC) x 6. (18)

R4: (SC 5, INC) x 3. (21)

R5: (SC 6, INC) x 3. (24)

R6-7: SC in each st around, ch 1. (24)


R8: Turn, BLO, SC in the same st, SC 23, sl st. (24)

R9: Ch 1, SC in the same st, SC 23, change to white to do the sl st. (24)

R10: Ch 1, SC in the same st, SC 23, change to blue to do the sl st. (24)

R11: Ch 1, SC in the same st, SC 23, sl st. (24)

– FO. Leave long tail to sew it with a few stitches to the top side of the head.



#### COLLAR (use white)

R1: Ch 17, SC 14, DEC, ch 1. (15)

R2-3: Turn, SC 15, ch 1. (15)

R4: Turn, sl st in the same st, sl st 10, SC 4, ch 1. (15)

R5-10: Turn, SC 4, ch 1. (4) R11: Turn, SC 4, ch 12. (16)

R12: Starting in second ch from hook, SC 15, ch 1. (15)

R13: Turn, SC 14, INC, ch 2 (to get that pointy look). (16)

R14: Turn, SC 16, ch 1. (16)

Lining of back part: SC in the same st, SC 12. (13)

- FO. Leave long tail for sewing. Weave the tail going to the inner opening of the collar to sew the collar to the doll's neck. Check the photo below to see how it is done.

# 1. SC 13 in the back lining of the collar.



3. Sew the collar starting from the back.



2. Weave the tail to the center opening of the collar.



4. Finish sewing the collar.




#### TAIL (use pink)

R1: Ch 10 or ch as much as how long you want the tail to be, starting in second ch from the hook, sl st 9. (9)

- FO. Leave tail to sew it on the back part of the body in between R26 and R27.

#### TAIL HAIR (use pink)

For the tail hair, insert the hook through the starting st of the tail and pull the middle part of a pink yarn halfway through the st and then pull the tail ends of the yarn through the loop and tighten. Brush the strand of the yarn. Cut and style.
