RAINBOW HANGING



Final Rainbow Measures: 1meter wide

This is a great stash buster using cotton aran weight yarns that you might have left over. I used an array of bright colours to make this Hanging with a rainbow in mind. Use your favourite yarn but I do suggest going up in hook size quite a bit to maximise the size of your rainbow.

Skill Level:

Materials:

La Mia Baby Cotton in your 6 favourite rainbow colours

5.5mm Hook

some washi tape to stick the rainbow onto your window. (it will not leave a sticky residue)

Stitches: (US Crochet Terms)

ch: chain

tr: treble crochet

st: stitch FO: fasten off

Notes:

ch 4 counts as a tr (the first tr in the row)

To change colours, wait until you reach the last tr before the colour change. When you have 2 loops on your hook on the last tr, use the new colour to close your st. Continue the pattern.

Pattern is worked in rows.

Starting with purple:

ch80, tr crochet in 4th ch from hook, tr in each ch and turn. [77 tr]

R1: ch4, (10 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times. and turn. [84 tr]

Change to blue:

R2: ch4, tr in each st

R3: ch4, (11 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times and turn. [91 tr]

Change to green:

R4: ch4, tr in each st

R5: ch4, (12 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times and turn. [98 tr]

Change to vellow:

R6: ch4, tr in each st

R7: ch4, (13 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times and turn. [105 tr]

Change to orange:

R8: ch4, tr in each st

R9: ch4, (14 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times and turn. [112 tr]

Change to pink:

R10: ch4, tr in each st

R11: ch4, (15 tr, 2 tr in same st) repeat 7 times and turn. [119 tr]

FO and weave in all ends.

Using washi tape, hang on your window in support of everyone who is helping with the current COVID-19 pandemic.
