

Nurse Bear

Amigurumi Pattern

Pattern designed by Tommy of Snips & Stitches



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Materials Needed~

- 2.75 mm (size C) crochet hook.
- 3 ply yarn in desired colors. I used La Mia Baby Cotton from Hobium Yarns.
- 7 mm safety eyes.
- Yarn needle.
- Polyester fiberfill stuffing.

Abbreviation Key (US terms)~

- St/sts- stitch(es)
- Sc- single crochet
- Hdc- half double crochet
- Dc- double crochet
- Sl st- slip stitch
- Dec- decrease
- Inc- increase
- Rep- repeat
- R- round
- Ch- Chain



Head (using brown yarn)~

R1: 6 sc into a magic circle. (6 sts)

R2: inc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3: (sc 1, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (18 sts)

R4: (sc 2, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (24 sts)

R5: (sc 3, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (30 sts)

R6: (sc 4, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (36 sts)

R7: (sc 5, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (42 sts)

R8-R15: sc 42. (8 rows total)

R16: (sc 5, dec)- rep 6x. (36 sts)

R17: (sc 4, dec)- rep 6x. (30 sts)

R18: (sc 3, dec)- rep 6x. (24 sts)

R19: (sc 2, dec)- rep 6x. (18 sts)

*Here, add the 7 mm eyes between **R11/12** about 9-10 sts apart. Embroider the nose in the middle of the eyes. Stuff the head.*

R20: (sc 1, dec)- rep 6x. (12 sts)

R21: dec- rep 6x. (6 sts)

Fasten off, add a little more stuffing, and sew the hole closed.

Ears (make 2 using brown yarn)~

R1: 6 sc into a magic circle. (6 sts)

R2: inc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3-R4: sc 12. (2 rows total)

R5: (sc 2, dec)- rep 3x. (9 sts)

Fasten off. Do not stuff the ears. Sew the ears on the sides of the head about 4-5 rows from the beginning magic circle.



Legs (make 2 starting with brown yarn)~

R1: 6 sc into a magic circle. (6 sts)

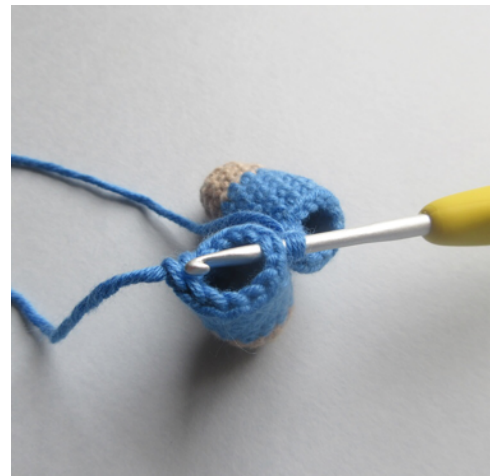
R2: inc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3-R4: sc 12 (2 rows total)

Change to blue yarn.

R5-R10: sc 12 (6 rows total)

Fasten off ONLY on the first leg, we will continue from the second leg to create the body. Stuff the legs firmly and continue on to make the body.



Body (continuing with blue yarn)~

Continued from the second leg...

Chain 2 - join to the 5th st of the first leg with a sc.

R11: sc in each st around joining the two legs together. (28 sts)

R12-R19: sc 28. (8 rows total)

R20: (sc 5, dec)- rep 4x. (24 sts)

R21-R22: sc 24. (2 rows total)

R23: (sc 2, dec)- rep 6x. (18 sts)

Change to brown.

R24: sc 18. (1 row total)

Fasten off and stuff the body firmly. Sew the body onto the bottom of the head.



Arms (make 2 starting with brown yarn)~

R1: 6 sc into a magic circle. (6 sts)

R2: (sc 2, inc in next st)- rep 2x. (8 sts)

R3-R7: sc 8. (5 rows total)

Change to blue.

R8-R10: sc 8. (3 rows total)

Fasten off and stuff the arms firmly. Sew the arms on the sides of the body.

Mask (using white yarn)~

Chain 7

R1: starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, sc 6, ch 1, turn (6 sts)

R2: sc 6, ch 1, turn (6 sts)

R3: sc 6 (6 sts)

R4: ch 32, join with a sc to the foundation ch, sc 5, ch 32, sl st in the first sc of **R3**.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Tie the mask around the bear's neck. Use the photo on page 8 for reference.



Hat (using blue yarn)~

R1: 6 sc into a magic circle. (6 sts)

R2: inc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3: (sc 1, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (18 sts)

R4: (sc 2, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (24 sts)

R5: (sc 3, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (30 sts)

R6: (sc 4, inc in next st)- rep 6x. (36 sts)

R7: inc, sc 5, ch 7, skip the next 6 sts,

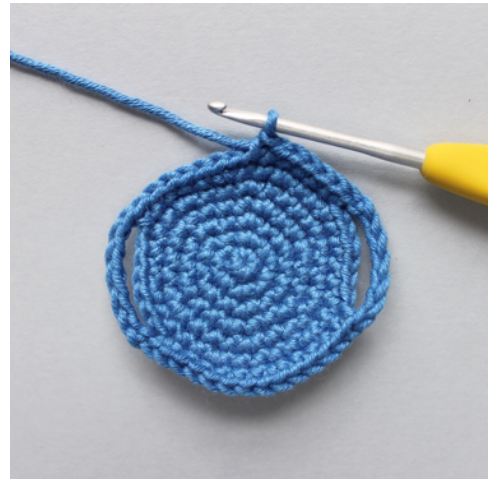
(inc, sc 5) - rep 2x, ch 7, skip the next 6 sts, inc, sc 5 (42 sts)

R8: sc in each st around. (42 sts)

R9: hdc 42. (1 row total)

R10: (front post hdc, back post hdc) - rep around. (42 sts)

Fasten off and weave in ends.



Heart (using red yarn)~

R1: sc, hdc, dc 3x, sl st, dc 3x, hdc, sc into a magic circle.

Fasten off and sew the heart onto the body.
