Skill Level: Beginner

Materials:

Yarn Art Jeans Plus in colours: turquois, white, black and red

Crochet Hook 4mm
Tapestry Needle

A pair of amigurumi eyes (9mm)

Stitches: (US Crochet Terms)

MR: magic ring ch: chain

sc: single crochet inc: increase

dec: decrease (I prefer invisible decrease)

st: stitches FO: fasten off

Snout [1]: white

R1: MR 6

R2: inc around (12)

R3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)

Clean FO and leaving long tail for sewing later.

Body[1]: teal

R1: MR 6

R2: inc around (12)

R3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)



R5: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)

R6: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)

R7-24: sc around [18 rounds]

*sew snout between R11-16, using black yarn embroider nose between 10-11; make a vertical line from middle of snout to top of snout. Using same black yarn, embroider nose two stitches wide between R10-11 [right above snout].

*add amigurumi eyes between R10-11, two stitches away from nose.

R25: (4 sc, dec) x6 (30)

R26: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)

R27: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)

*stuff firmly as you go.

R28: (sc, dec) x 6 (12)

R29: dec around (6)

FO, weave in all ends.

Ears [2]: teal

R1: MR 6

R2: sc around

Flatten and FO, leaving long tail for sewing.

Arms and Legs [4]: teal

R1: MR 4

B2: inc around

R3-4: sc around [2 rounds]

Flatten and FO, leaving long tail for sewing.

Bow Tie [1]: red worked in ROWS

ch9, sc in second ch from the hook and sc in remaining 7 ch.

R1-2: ch1, turn, sc in all 8 st. [repeat 2 times]

FO, leaving long tail for sewing. Using tapestry needle, weave the long end to the centre of the rectangle you just made. Then use the yarn tail to wrap around the centre of the rectangle to create the centre of bowtie. Secure.

Assembly:

Sew ears around R4-7, above eyes. Sew arms around R14-17, two stitches away from snout. Sew legs on R 24, aligning with arms that are above. Sew bow tie below snout. Weave in all ends.
