

### Materials:

- 3mm, 4mm and 5mm Crochet Hook
- Himalaya Dolphin Baby yarn in colour Yellow and White or your chosen chenille yarn
- Any worsted weight yarn for the stripes
- Himalaya Anti-Pilling yarn in colour yellow for the crown or any other DK yarn
- Darning needle
- Scissors
- Embroidery thread for sewing (optional)
- Fibre filling
- 12mm or 14mm safety eyes (optional)

Finished Bee measures approximately 15cm long.

## Abbreviations: (US TERMINOLOGY)

RD - Round

SS - Slip Stitch

FO - Fasten off

CH - Chain

SC - Single Crochet

**BLO - Back Loop Only**

#### **Directions**

## BODY: (Using a 4mm or 5mm hook)

\*\* Working in continuous spiral rounds into a magic ring; do not CH 1 unless pattern specifies.

RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring (6)

RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch all the way around (12)

RD 3) 1 SC into the first stitch, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (18)

RD 4) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (24)

### PLACE SAFETY EYES SECURELY HERE

RD 5) 1 SC into the first 3 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

RD 6) 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)

RD 7) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (42)

RD 8) 1 SC into the first 6 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (48)

RD 9-12) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((4 rounds))

RD 13-14) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((2 rounds))

RD 15-16) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((2 rounds))

RD 17-18) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((2 rounds))

RD 19-20) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((2 rounds))

RD 21-22) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((2 rounds))

#### **CHANGE COLOUR HERE**

RD 23) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48)

RD 24) 1 SC into the first 6 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (42)

RD 25) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)

RD 26) 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

RD 27) 1 SC into the first 3 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (24)

RD 28) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (18)

RD 29) 1 SC into the first stitch, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (12)

RD 30) INV DEC all the way around, SS into the next stitch, FO, cut yarn and weave in ends (6)



EYES: (MAKE 2 Using a 4mm hook)

RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring, SS into the next stitch, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing

Sew on the eyes between RD 4-5 of the bees face if not using safety eyes.

If using safety eyes attach between RD 4-5

# MOUTH:

Using your chosen coloured yarn or embroidery thread; sew on a small "V" shaped smile line 1 stitch apart



# WINGS: (MAKE 2 Using a 4mm hook)

\*\*Working into a magic ring

RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring (6)

RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch all the way around (12)

RD 3) 1 SC into the first stitch, 2 SC into the next stitch, repeat all the way around (18)

RD 4) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around, SS into the next stitch, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing (24)



Using a Darning needle; sew on the wings in the centre of the bees body 3 stitches apart

## CROWN: (Using a 3mm hook)

\*\*Working into a magic ring

RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring (6)

RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch all the way around (12)

RD 3) 1 SC into the first stitch, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (18)

RD 4) working into the BLO; 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (18)

RD 5) working back into both loops 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (18)

RD 5) CH 2; 1 DC back into the same stitch, CH 2, 2 DC back into the same stitch \*1 SC into the next 2 stitches along

2 DC into the next stitch, CH 2, 2 DC back into the same stitch, repeat from \* all the way around, SS into the bottom of the first CH 2 from the beginning of the round, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.
