



Materials:

- 3mm and 4.5mm Crochet Hook
- Himalaya Dolphin Baby yarn in colour White, Red, Orange and Black or your chosen worsted weight yarn
- Darning needle
- Scissors
- Embroidery thread for sewing (optional)
- Fibre filling
- 12mm or 14mm safety eyes (optional)
- Button or flat back resin button
- Craft glue

Finished Snowman measures approximately 20cm tall.

Abbreviations: (US TERMINOLOGY)

RD - Round

SS - Slip Stitch

FO - Fasten off

CH - Chain

SC - Single Crochet

DC - Double Crochet

FLO - Front Loop Only

BLO - Back Loop Only

INV DEC - Invisible Decrease (Tutorial on how to Invisible decrease below) https://youtu.be/OUBbOZ1Ennk

BS - Bobble Stitch: YO,pull up a loop, YO pull through 2 loops on the hook, repeat 5 times until you have 6 loops on the hook, YO, pull through all 6 loops on the hook (Tutorial on how to Bobble Stitch below)

Directions

HEAD/BODY: (Using a 4.5mm hook)

^{**} Working into a magic ring

- RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring (6)
- RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch all the way around (12)
- RD 3) 1 SC into the first stitch, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (18)
- RD 4) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (24)
- RD 5) 1 SC into the first 3 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)
- RD 6) 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)
- RD 7) 1 SC into the next 5 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (42)
- RD 8-13) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (42) ((6 rounds))

PLACE SAFETY EYES HERE 6 STITCHES APART

RD 14-17) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (42) ((4 rounds))



RD 18) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)

RD 19) 1 SC into the first 4 stitches; INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

STUFF FIRMLY WITH FIBRE FILLING HERE

RD 20) 1 SC into the first 3 stitches; INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (24)

RD 21) Working into the FLO; 1 SC into the first 3 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

RD 22) Working back into both loops; 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)

RD 23) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (42)

RD 24-27) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (42) ((4 rounds))

RD 28) 1 SC into the first 6 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (48)

RD 29-35) 1 SC into each stitch all the way around (48) ((7 rounds))

RD 36) 1 SC into the first 6 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (42)

RD 37) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (36)

STUFF FIRMLY WITH FIBRE FILLING HERE

RD 38) Working into the BLO, 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch repeat all the way around (30)

RD 39) Working back into both loops, 1 SC into the first 3 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (24)

ADD A LITTLE MORE FIBRE FILLING HERE

RD 40) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (18)

RD 41) 1 SC into the first stitch, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (12)

RD 42) INV DEC all the way around, SS into the next stitch, FO, cut yarn and weave in ends (6)



NOSE: (Using a 3mm hook)

** working into a magic ring

RD 1) 4 SC into a magic ring (4)

RD 2) 2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next 3 stitches (5)

RD 3) 2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next 4 stitches (6)

RD 4) 2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next 5 stitches (7)

RD 5) 2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next 6 stitches, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing (8)

Sew on the nose just below the centre of the eyes evenly spaced apart between RD 14-15





SCARF: (Using a 3mm hook)

ROW 1) CH 56; working into the 2nd CH from the hook 1 DC all the way across, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing (54)

Using a darning needle and same coloured thread securely fasten the scarf around the snowman neck overlapping the scarf at the end





MITTENS: (Using a 3mm hook)

** Working into a magic ring

RD 1) 6 SC into a magic ring (6)

RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch around (12)

RD 3-4) 1 SC into each stitch around ((2 rounds)) (12)

RD 5) 1 SC into the first 5 stitches, BS into the next stitch, 1 SC into the next 6 stitches (12)

RD 6) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (9)

RD 7) working into the FLO, 2 SC into each stitch around, FO, Cut yarn and weave in ends (18)

CHANGE COLOUR TO BODY COLOUR

RD 8) Working into the BLO of RD 7, 1 SC into each stitch around (9)

RD 9-12) 1 SC into each stitch around, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing ((4 rounds)) (9)

Sew on the arms evenly spaced apart, just under the scarf so that the join line is hidden, making sure that the bobble is facing outwards on each mitten.



COAL BUTTON: (Using a 3mm hook)

** Working into a magic ring

RD 1) 4 SC into a magic ring, FO, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing (4)

Alternatively you can use a coloured button and securely fasten it to the centre of the snowman body



HAT: (Using a 3mm hook)

**Working into a magic ring

RD 1) 10 SC into a magic ring (10)

RD 2) 2 SC into each stitch all the way around (20)

RD 3) 1 SC into the first stitch, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (25)

RD 4) 1 SC into the first 2 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

RD 5) 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, 2 SC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around, 1 SC into the next 2 stitches (36)

RD 4) Working into the BLO; 1 SC into each stitch around (36)

RD 5) Working back into both loops; 1 SC into the first 4 stitches, INV DEC into the next stitch; repeat all the way around (30)

RD 6-7) 1 SC into each stitch around ((2 rounds)) (30)

RD 8) Working into the FLO; 1 SC into each stitch around (30)

RD 9) Working back into both loops; 2 SC into each stitch around, FO, Cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing (60)

HAT TRIM: (Using a 2.5mm hook)

CH as many stitches as you need to attach all the way around the brim of the hat, Sew onto the hat using a darning needle, FO, Cut yarn and weave in ends
