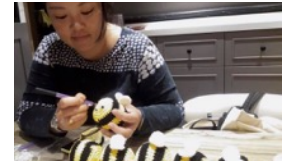

Skill Level: Beginner

Materials:

Kartopu Organica Prints in [Light Blue H2185](#)

Kartopu Organica in [Grey K1921](#)

Crochet Hook 2.25mm

Stuffing

White embroidery yarn

Tapestry Needle

Stitches: (US Crochet Terms)

MR: magic ring

sc: single crochet

inc: increase

dec: decrease (or invisible decrease)

st: stitches

BLO: back loop only

FLO: front loop only

FO: fasten off

Bauble [Make one]

Using Light Blue Yarn:

R1: 6sc in MR [6]

R2: inc around [12]

R3: (sc, inc) repeat 6x [18]

R4: (sc 2, inc) repeat 6x [24]

R5: (sc 3, inc) repeat 6x [30]

R6: (sc 4, inc) repeat 6x [36]

R7: (sc 5, inc) repeat 6x [42]

R8: (sc 6, inc) repeat 6x [48]

R9: (sc 7, inc) repeat 6x [54]

R10: (sc 8, inc) repeat 6x [60]

R11: (sc 9, inc) repeat 6x [66]

R12-17: sc around (6 rounds)

R18: (sc 9, dec) repeat 6x [60]

R19: (sc 8, dec) repeat 6x [54]

R20: (sc 7, dec) repeat 6x [48]

R21: (sc 6, dec) repeat 6x [42]

R22: (sc 5, dec) repeat 6x [36]

R23: (sc 4, dec) repeat 6x [30]

R24: (sc 3, dec) repeat 6x [24]

R25: (sc 2, dec) repeat 6x [18]

stuff firmly as you go

switch to grey yarn

R26: sc around FLO

R27-28: sc around (through both loops)

R29: (sc, dec) x6 through BLO [12]

R30: dec around [6]

FO and use the long tail to close your work.

Using same long tail, create a loop and secure with few stitches (and knots if you prefer) so you can hang the bauble onto your tree. Weave in all ends.



Embroidery:

Using a small tapestry needle and white embroidery yarn (or Kartopu Organica in white) embroider some stars and little dots around the middle of the bauble. Secure all ends and weave them in.

You can embroider anything you like but I did something simple and it felt festive and cute to me. :)

Glittery yarns would look especially nice embroidered onto the bauble. I feel these would make a nice gift for friends and family as well.
