

The 2 Way Cup Cozy

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Materials:

Any Worsted Weight Yarn #4 (For this cozy I teamed up with Hobium Yarns Company, @hobiumyarns on IG and the yarn I used for the cozies picture above is called “Yarn Art Charisma Yarn”, it is a #3 yarn but its works like a #4 yarn. You can find it on their website www.hobiumyarns.com).

Hook: H/5mm (If you have loose tension then you may want to drop back to a 4.5mm)

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

Crochet Terms:

Ch 1 – Chain 1

Sl st – Slip Stitch

SC – Single Crochet

HDC – Half Double Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

CLS – Cluster Stitch

FP HDC – Front Post Half Double Crochet Stitch

FO – Fasten Off

Special instructions for the Cluster Stitch:

Yarn over and insert hook into stitch, Yarn over and pull up a loop, Yarn over and pull through 2 loops only, **(2 loops on hook)**. Yarn over and insert hook into the same stitch, Yarn over and pull up a loop, Yarn over and pull through 2 loops only, **(3 loops on hook)**. Yarn over and insert hook into the same stitch, Yarn over and pull up a loop, Yarn over and pull through 2 loops only, **(4 loops on hook)**. Yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on hook, **DO NOT CHAIN 1 after. If you are not sure then hit the link below for a how-to video. Mine you will only yarn over 3 times until you have 4 loops on your hook not 5. Also, Remember DO NOT CHAIN 1.**

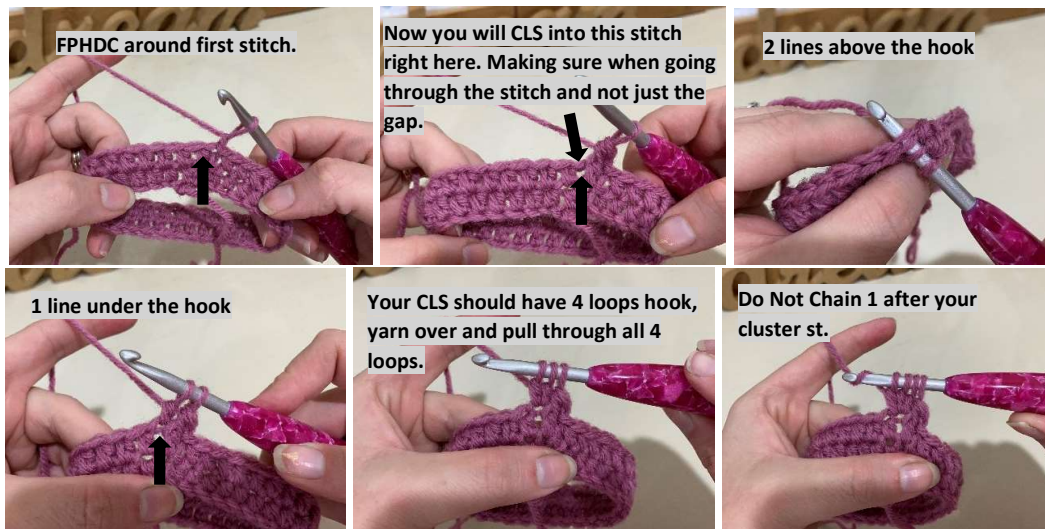
Lets Begin:

Round 1: Ch 30, Sl st to first Ch, Ch 1, HDC in same chain (Joining chain) (I do this in the back loops along the back of the stitches, it makes the bottom neater), HDC in each chain/loop around, Sl st to first HDC. **Ch 1. (30)**

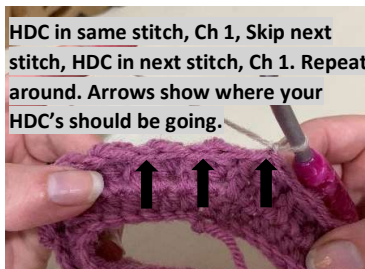
Round 2: HDC in same stitch and in each stitch around, Sl st to first HDC. **Ch 1. (30)**

Round 3: *FPHDC around same stitch, CLS in next stitch*, (in behind the FPHDC stitch, making sure your hook goes into the actual stitch and not just the space, might be a little fiddly but make sure you have 2 loops over your hook and one under). Repeat *-* around, Sl stitch to first FPHDC. **Ch 1. (30) (See photos below for reference).**

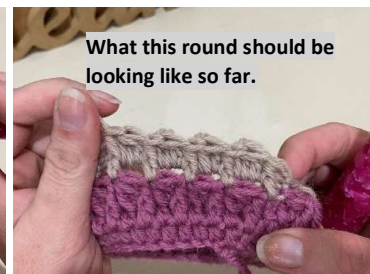
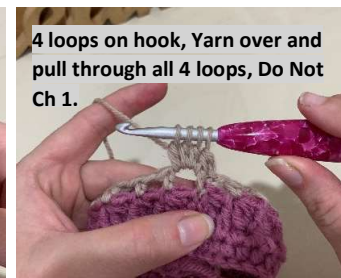




Round 4: HDC in same stitch, Ch 1, Skip next stitch, *HDC in next stitch, Ch 1, Skip next stitch*, Repeat *-* around, you will end on a Ch1, Sl st to first HDC. **Ch 1. (30)**



Round 5: FPHDC around same stitch, CLS into Ch1 space, *FPHDC around next stitch, CLS into Ch 1 space*, Repeat *-* around, Sl st to first FPHDC. **Ch 1. (30)**



Round 6: Repeat Round 4. (30)

Round 7: Repeat Round 5. (30)

Round 8: Repeat Round 4. (30)

Round 9: Repeat Round 5. (30)

Round 10: *FPHDC around same stitch, HDC in next stitch* (like round 3, it is close in behind the FPHDC (**See above pictures**) and make sure you are going into the stitch not just the space), Repeat *-* around, Sl st to first FPHDC. **CH 1. (30)**

Round 11: Repeat Round 2. (30) FO and sew in ends. (**See below photos of how it should look with both ways**). If you want the shell look around the top, then do not FO and follow instructions below.



NOTE: This Cozy is a two-way cozy can be worn inside out also which gives the cozy a whole new look and feel. If you do not want to use your cozy both ways and prefer the right way to be out and you want a cool shell look around the top, then **follow shell round instructions below to finish it off**. Note, it can be used inside out also with the shells if you like also, just the neat side of the shells will be facing in.

Shell Round: SC,HDC,3xDC,HDC,SC into the same stitch, Skip next 2 stitches, *SC,HDC,3xDC,HDC,SC into next stitch, Skip next 2 stitches*, Repeat *-* around, you'll have 2 stitches left, Skip them, Sl st to first SC. **(30)** FO and sew in ends.
