# Honey the Bee by Whimsical Yarn Creations

## Materials:

Hook size: 3.25 mm	- Color D: Yarn End Amigurumi – Pink (033) ( <b>Less than 5 g</b> )
Yarn: DK Weight Yarn	Safety eyes: 10.50 mm
-Color A: Yarn End Amigurumi – Yellow (006) ( <b>25 g</b> )	Stitch Marker (recommended)
- Color B: Yarn End Amigurumi – Black (04) ( <b>15 g</b> )	Fiberfil stuffing
- Color C: Yarn End Amigurumi – Ecru (028) ( <b>10 g</b> )	Tapestry needle
	Scissors

## Abbreviations:

ch: chain	inc: increase
MR: magic ring	dec: decrease
sl st: slip stitch	FO: finish off
sc: single crochet	( ): repeat what is in parenthesis
hdc: half double crochet	[ ]: total number of stitches in the round
dc: double crochet	sts: stitches
tr: treble crochet	

## Size:

6.5 inches/16.5 centimeters tall when made with the recommended yarn, hook size and yarn under.

## Gauge:

Not critical but may affect the amount of yarn used.

## Yarn under:

Insert your hook under the top two loops, yarn under, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through both loops. This creates an “x” stitch.

## Head:

*Stuff as you go.*

Using Color A, make 1.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6]

2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]

4: (Sc, inc, sc) x 6. [24]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6. [30]

6: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6. [36]

7: (5 sc, inc) x 6. [42]

8: (3 sc, inc, 3 sc) x 6. [48]

9-20: 48 sc. [48]

*Secure eyes between rounds 14 & 15 with 6 visible stitches in between each eye.*

21: (3 sc, dec, 3 sc) x 6. [42]

22: (5 sc, dec) x 6. [36]

23: (2 sc, dec, 2 sc) x 6. [30]

24: (3 sc, dec) x 6. [24]

25: (Sc, dec, sc) x 6. [18]

26: (Sc, dec) x 6. [12]

27: Dec x 6. [6]

FO and weave end through the remaining front loops.

## Body:

Using Colors A and B, make 1.

*Stuff as you go.*

*Start with Color B.*

1: 4 sc in MR. [4]

2: Inc, 3 sc. [5]

3: 5 sc. [5]

4: Inc, 4 sc. [6]

5: Inc x 6. [12]

6: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]

7: (Sc, inc, sc) x 6. [24]

8: (3 sc, inc) x 6. [30]

9: 30 sc. [30]

10: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6. [36]

11: (5 sc, inc) x 6. [42]

12-13: 42 sc. [42]

*Change to Color A.*

14-15: 42 sc. [42]

16: (12 sc, dec) x 3. [39]

17: 39 sc. [39]

*Change to Color B.*

18: 39 sc. [39]

19: (11 sc, dec) x 3. [36]

20-21: 36 sc. [36]

*Change to Color A.*

22: 36 sc. [36]

23: (7 sc, dec) x 4. [32]

24: (3 sc, dec, 3 sc) x 4. [28]

25: 28 sc. [28]

*Change to Color B.*

26: 28 sc. [28]

27: (5 sc, dec) x 4. [24]

28-29: 24 sc. [24]

FO and leave a long tail for sewing.



# Honey the Bee by Whimsical Yarn Creations

## Wings:

Using Color C, make 2.

- 1: 6 sc in MR. [6]
- 2: Inc x 6. [12]
- 3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]
- 4: Hdc inc, dc inc, tr inc x 5, dc inc, sl st, dc inc, tr inc x 5, dc inc, hdc inc, hdc, sl st in next st. [35]

FO and leave a long tail for sewing.



## Antenna:

Using Color B, make 2.

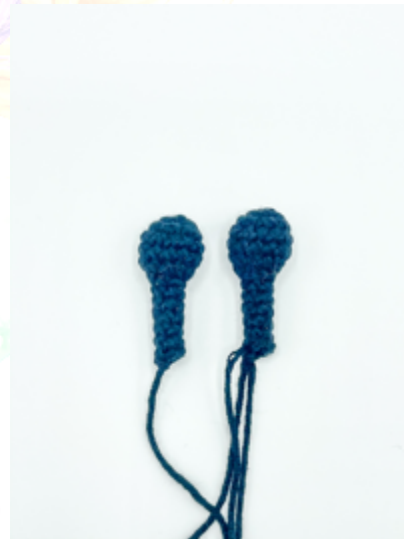
- 1: 6 sc in MR. [6]
- 2: Inc x 6. [12]
- 3-5: 12 sc. [12]

*As you decrease in the next round, stuff your antenna.*

- 6: Dec x 6. [6]
- 7-12: 6 sc. [6]

*The only part that is stuffed is the top of the antenna.*

FO and leave a long tail for sewing.



# Honey the Bee by Whimsical Yarn Creations

## Assembly:

### Option 1

1. Sew the body to the side of the head between rounds 13-21. Add more stuffing before you finish sewing.



2. Sew the wings to the body between rounds 17-25 with approximately 9 stitches in between on round 25.



3. Sew the antennae to the head between rounds 6-8. Embroider little pink cheeks with Color D next to the eyes and a smile with black yarn.





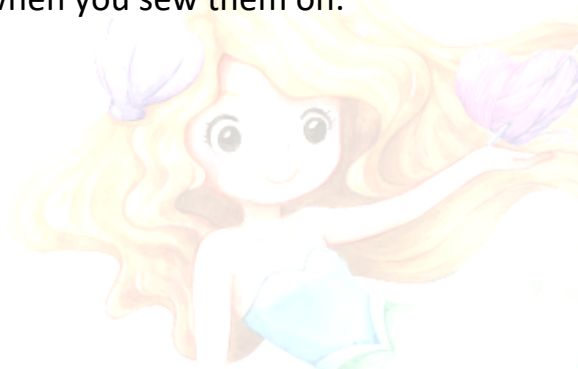
# Honey the Bee by Whimsical Yarn Creations

## Option 2

1. Sew the body to the head. Add more stuffing before you finish sewing.



2. Sew the wings to the back of the body between rounds 19-24 with approximately 3 stitches in between. Make sure the wrong side is facing you when you sew them on.



3. Sew the antennas to the head between rounds 6-8. Embroider little pink cheeks with Color D next to the eyes and a smile with black yarn.
