

Materials:

Hook size: 4 mm

Yarn: Worsted Weight Yarn:

-Color A: Yarn Art Jeans Plus – Baby

Pink- #74 (75g)

- Color B: White for Pom Pom tail

(25g)

Safety eyes: 15 mm

Stitch Marker (recommended)

Fiberfil stuffing Tapestry needle

Scissors

Small Pom Pom maker Pink embroidery thread

Abbreviations:

ch: chain

MR: magic ring sl st: slip stitch sc: single crochet inc: increase

dec: decrease

FO: finish off

(): repeat what is in parenthesis []: total number of stitches in the

round

sts: stitches

Síze:

8.5 inches/21.5 centimeters tall when made with the recommended yarn, hook size and yarn under.

Gauge:

Not critical but may affect the amount of yarn used.

Yarn under:

Insert your hook under the top two loops, yarn under, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through both loops. This creates an "x" stitch.

Head:

Stuff as you go. Using Color A, make 1.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6] 2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]

4: (Sc, inc, sc) x 6. [24]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6. [30]

6: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6. [36]

7: 36 sc. [36]

8: (5 sc, inc) x 6. [42]

9: (3 sc, inc, 3 sc) x 6. [48]

10-16: 48 sc. [48]

17: 9 sc, (inc, sc) x 3, 18 sc, (inc, sc) x

3, 9 sc. [54]

18: 9 sc, (2 sc, inc) x 3, 18 sc, (2 sc,

inc) x 3, 9 sc. [60]

19: (4 sc, dec, 4 sc) x 6. [54]

20: (7 sc, dec) x 6. [48]

Insert safety eyes now. Place between round 15 & 16 with 6 visible sts in

between.

21: (3 sc, dec, 3 sc) x 6. [42]

22: (5 sc, dec) x 6. [36]

23: (2 sc, dec, 2 sc) x 6. [30]

24: (3 sc, dec) x 6. [24]

25: (Sc, dec, sc) x 6. [18]

26: (Sc, dec) x 6. [12]

27: Dec x 6. [6]

FO and weave end through the remaining front loops.

Body:

Stuff as you go.
Using Color A, make 1.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6] 2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18] 4: (Sc, inc, sc) x 6. [24]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6. [30]

6: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6. [36]

7: (5 sc, inc) x 6. [42]

8: (3 sc, inc, 3 sc) x 6. [48]

9-12: 48 sc. [48]

13: (Sc, dec) x 4, 36 sc. [44]

14: (Dec, 2 sc) x 2, 36 sc. [42]

15-16: 42 sc. [42]

17: (5 sc, dec) x 6. [36]

18-20: 36 sc. [36]

21: (2 sc, dec, 2 sc) x 6. [30]

22-23: 30 sc. [30]

24: (3 sc, dec) x 6. [24]

25-26: 24 sc. [24]

FO and leave a long tail for sewing.



Arms:

Using Color A, make 2.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6]

2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (3 sc, inc) x 3. [15]

4-5: 15 sc. [15]

6: Dec x 3, 9 sc. [12]

7: (4 sc, dec) x 2. [10]


Start stuffing.

8-17: 10 sc. [10]

Stop stuffing after round 12.

18: 3 sc (adjust as needed to get to the side

of the arm), flatten and 5 sc across.





Using Color A, make 2. Stuff very lightly.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6]

2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]

4-6: 18 sc. [18]

7: (4 sc, dec) x 3. [15]

8-10: 15 sc. [15]

11: (3 sc, dec) x 3. [12]

12: (Sc, dec, sc) x 3. [9]

13: (Sc, dec) x 3. [6]

FO and leave a long tail for sewing. Weave ends through the FLO of the last round.





Ears:

Using Color A, make 2. Don't stuff.

1: 5 sc in MR. [5]

2: (Sc, inc) x 2, sc. [7]

3: 7 sc. [7]

4: (2 sc, inc) x 2, sc. [9]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 2, sc. [11]

6: (4 sc, inc) x 2, sc. [13]

7: 13 sc. [13]

8: (5 sc, inc) x 2, sc. [15]

9-13: 15 sc. [15]

14: (3 sc, dec) x 3. [12]

15: (2 sc, dec) x 3. [9]

16: Flatten and 4 sc across.



FO and leave a long tail for sewing. Using your yarn tail, sew the ends together.

Muzzle:

Using Color A, make 1.

1: 6 sc in MR. [6]

2: Inc x 6. [12]

3: (Sc, inc) x 6. [18]

4: (5 sc, inc) x 3. [21]

FO and leave a long tail for sewing.



Assembly:

1. Sew the body to the head. The defined belly (with decreases) goes in the front. Add extra stuffing before closing.



2. Sew the feet to the bottom of the body between rounds 3 & 6. The heel goes a little below the magic ring. I sew around the back edge of the foot (approx..3 rounds on either side).





3. Sew the arms starting between rounds 24 & 25 on a slight angle. The decreases face the inside of the body.





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4. Sew the ears starting between rounds 5 & 6, with 7 stitches in between.





6. Make a tail with a small pom pom maker using Color B. Attach the tail to the back of the bunny.





7. Sew the muzzle between rounds 14 & 22. Embroider a nose.





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
