

Vintage granny square baby blanket



Materials needed

Worsted weight yarn (I used La Mia Wool Easy) US I/5.5 mm crochet hook yarn needle scissors

Yardage

780 m (853 yds)

Abbreviations

R: round

MR: Magic Ring

ch(s): chain(s)

dc: double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

ch3-sp: chain 3-space

st(s): stitch(es)

blo: back loop only

Gauge

13 st and 8 rows is 4 inches in dc

Dimensions

35x35 inches (89x89 cm)

Notes

- 1. Read all the pattern before you begin crocheting.
- 2. The pattern is worked in joined rounds.
- 3. The first stitch of every round is worked in the same stitch as the slip stitch.

The pattern

R1: MR, ch 2, * 3 dc, ch 3 * repeat from * to * 3 more times, sl st to join in the first dc.

R2: ch 2, * dc in each st until ch3-sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch3-sp *, repeat from * to * 3 more times, sl st in first dc.

R3-28: ch 2, * dc in each st until ch3-sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch3-sp *, repeat from * to * 3 more times, dc in all remaining st(s), sl st in first dc.

Border:

R29: ch 1, * sc in each st across, 3 sc in ch3-sp *, repeat from * to * around, sc in all remaining st(s), sl st in first sc.

R30-33: ch 1, * sc in blo in each st across, 3 sc in the middle sc of the ch3-sp of the previous round *, repeat from * to * around, sc in all remaining st(s) across, sl st in first sc.

Fasten off and weave in all ends. That's it! Enjoy!

Color changes:

Color A: smoked grey L207 (2 skeins)

Color B: grey L206 (2 skeins)

R1-16: color A

R17-23: color B

R24-28: color A

R29-33 (border): color B

This is a square blanket, which means you can make it smaller or larger by adding or substracting rows. It will be always be a square though.

You can make it as small as a lovey and as big as a receiving blanket.
